Floats will be judged and trophies given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place

With this fun theme, we hope you'll use your imaginations and skills to create some really great entries!

Judging Guidelines

Workmanship: (25 points)

The overall workmanship of the entire float includes neatness, detail, use of material and/or flowers, and use of skirting so it appears to "float."

Identifications: (10 points)

Signs depicting float name, family / business / organization and/or sponsor. A sign cannot be the central emphasis of a float.

Theme and Design: (25 points)

How well does each float depict the subject that the float is representing? The scene and characters presented on a float should be readily associated with its selected title.

Animation and Sound: (20 points)

Is there music? Is the animation and sound keeping with the theme of the float and parade? Is the sound working during judging? Is sound audible?

[Judging of the floats will be at the St. James Church parking lot. Participants must be on the float for judging. Music should not be played until requested by judges. Parade line up begins at 3:00 p.m. The parade will start promptly at 4:00 p.m.]
